

WHO?

Textile designer Heather Lins seamlessly integrates modern design and artisan production techniques in her studio, Heather Lins Home.

WHAT?

Current collections center on home textiles for the sofa and the table. Each design is a balance of wit, beauty and timeless design.

- **Eye Chart Collection:** Removed from the doctor's office, an eye chart is a charming sight. Two pillows make up this collection: one in stereo and one in analog. 3-D glasses included.
- **Numbered Edition Collection:** A ruler motif lines a place mat, while coasters and napkins are numbered sequentially. A study in vintage typography, these pieces work separately or as a full collection.
- **Conversation Pieces Collection:** Conversation bubbles populate this trio of pillows.

HOW?

All pieces are screen-printed with water-based inks onto natural-fiber fabrics. Each item is unique, reflecting the hand of the artisan who made it. All pieces are printed and sewn in the U.S.A.
